The PE100+ Association successfully organised a seminar cycle in Spain PE100+ Association seminar cycle "PE100+: De tour por Espana"

PE100+ Association seminar cycle "PE100+: De tour por Espana"

Together with AseTUB, the association of Spanish pipe & fitting producers, the PE100+ Association organised a seminar cycle in four locations. The target of those seminars was to show the outstanding performance of the piping material Polyethylene 100 (PE100) and to ensure all the participants about the safety transport possibilities of drinking water, natural gas and industrial fluids using pipelines made of PE.

The seminar cycle started on April 26th in Seville, continued on May 8th in Madrid, on May 10th in Bilbao and ended on May 17th in Barcelona. In total, over 200 participants used the possibility to gather information about the use of PE100 materials and to take part in discussions with representatives from the total industry. All speeches were held in the local language.

The general program started with some introduction about the activities of the PE100+ Association on a European level and continued with detailed technical and commercial comparisons of PE100 materials with other plastics as well as with traditional materials. The main part of the day was dedicated to both speeches and project descriptions by representatives from both the gas and water industry, and standardisation and education bodies.
